## MAKING MUSIC

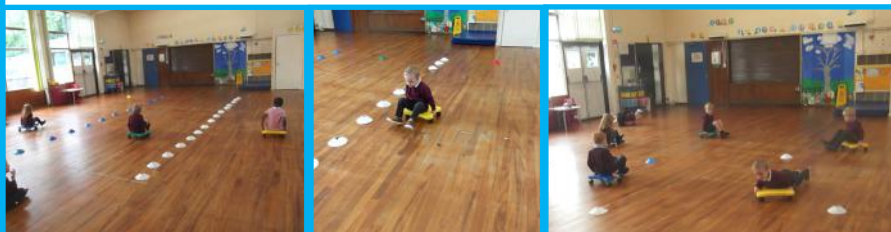


Some of our keyworker children have been learning about music and the different types of musical instruments. They have also been making their own wonderful music with bells!
